



### Large Water Main Break on the Northwest Side of Waukesha

There was a large water main break last night in the area of N University Drive and Chatsworth Circle. The break affected water services on the northwest side of Waukesha.

If you're still experiencing low water pressure, rusty water, or some air in your plumbing, please run the cold water in your lower-level laundry tubs or your outside hose bib until the rusty colored water is clear.

Only after the water returns to normal should laundry and other water projects be resumed.

If there is no water or reduced pressure at your kitchen sink, you may want to unscrew the aerator at the end of the kitchen faucet and rinse off the screen before placing it back in. If you have water at your other fixtures, and still not at your kitchen sink after rinsing the aerator, you might have to call a plumber.

If you have no water throughout the entire house, please bypass your water softener. If you still have no water throughout your house, after bypassing the softener, then contact the Water Utility at 262-521-5272.
